Ugo didn't want to simply take New York and put it in Miami, he wanted to create something that stood out and looked different. It's safe to say Julien and Ugo were the perfect collaborators in this shared vision. Ugo's hope is that people will appreciate the artistic creativity behind the project when they see it.

The Main Pool (along with the Gym and Spa) had to be placed on the top floor because as Ugo puts it "a pool has to be in the sun, what's the point of having a pool if it's not in the sun?"

360 degree rooftop views are often reserved for exclusive penthouse apartments but because the top floor is a dedicated public space, the Flatiron will provide this access to all of its residents. This was a carefully considered feature Ugo insisted on providing.
